The figures and tables should be prepared by using the text box below (by copying and pasting the text box) to avoid formatting errors. Please prepare each figure including any labels as one image file.

Keywords: please provide up to five keywords, separated by semi-colon (;) (Times New Roman 10pt)

Background (Time New Roman 10pt Bold)

Font: please use Time New Roman font for the whole paper except mathematical symbols.

Font size: 10 points for the whole paper except title (Bold Arial, 14 points).

Paper size: A4 (210x297 mm); Margin: top 25.4 mm; bottom: 25.4 mm; left: 25.4 mm; right: 25.4 mm,

Line spacing: single, please give 1.5 spaced between line of text.

Language: please write the full paper in good English.

Header, Footer, Page Numbering

Authors are asked to replace the "XXX" number (with the paper code that was assigned when the paper was accepted) on the header of the first page and on the footer of other pages in order to set a unique page number in the Proceedings.




Figure 1 Number of patents on nanotechnology with time

All figures and tables presented in the full paper must be numbered in the order that they appear in the text and must be referred to in the text. Within your text, Table and Figure must always be written out in full, for example **Figure 1**, using bold Times New Roman 10 points.

Footnotes should be numbered consecutively and situated at the bottom of the corresponding page, NOT at the end of the manuscript. It is strongly recommended to reduce their number as much as possible and to use them JUST for clarifying and explanatory purposes, NOT for bibliographical reference.

You can ALSO include NON-TEXTUAL ELEMENTS such as also graphs, tables, figures, maps and images.

The full manuscripts are compiled into the conference Proceedings.

CONCLUSION

ACKNOWLEDGEMENTS

A short acknowledgement section can be written between the conclusion and the references. Sponsorship and financial support acknowledgments should be included here. Acknowledging the contributions of other colleagues who are not included in the authorship of this paper is also added in this section. If no acknowledgement is necessary, this section should not appear in the paper.
